The following changes, additions, and/or clarifications to the Contract Documents shall be incorporated in said documents and shall be allowed for in the unit prices bid by the Contractor such that the unit prices indicated in the Bid Form shall represent the conditions as set forth in the Contract Documents and this addendum. The bidder shall acknowledge the receipt of this addendum on page 1 of the Bid Form and on the attached receipt.

Bids remain due at the original bid time and date of October 22, 2018 at 2:00 pm.

This Addendum contains seven pages (two addendum No.1, one acknowledgement form, and four SECTION 00 41 00 BID FORM).

ADDITIONS AND CHANGES TO THE PLANS

1. Add the following notes to sheet 4:

“VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC NEED NOT BE MAINTAINED WITHIN THE WORK ZONE DURING CONSTRUCTION. THE ROAD MUST BE READY AND OPENED TO TRAFFIC BY THE SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION DATE.”

“A MINIMUM OF THREE TYPE III BARRICADES WITH ONE ROAD CLOSED SIGN SHALL BE PLACED AT EACH END OF THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE UNTIL SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION. THIS WORK IS INCLUDED IN MINOR TRAF DEVICES.”

“ALL PERMITS HAVE BEEN APPLIED FOR BY THE OWNER FOR THIS PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY PERMIT FEES.”

2. Add the following notes to sheet 5:

“THE CUT COPPER UTILITY ATTACHED TO THE NORTH FASCIA OF THE BRIDGE IS PROPOSED TO BE TEMPORARILY RELOCATED ABOVE GROUND AND TO THE NORTH OUT OF THE WAY OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION BY THE END OF OCTOBER 2018. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS DIRECTLY ON GETTING THE TEMPORARY ABOVE GROUND UTILITY PLACED OVER THE PROPOSED CULVERT AND BURRIED PRIOR TO FINAL RESTORATION. THIS WORK IS INCIDENTAL TO THE CONTRACT.”

“THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PERFORMING CONCRETE QC FOR THE CAST-IN-PLACE END TREATMENTS OF THE CULVERT. THIS WORK IS INCIDENTAL TO THE CONTRACT.”

ADDITIONS AND CHANGES TO THE SPECIFICATIONS

SECTION 00 21 13 – INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

3. Delete section 9.01 in Article 9 – Contract Times in its entirety and replace with the following language:

The times by which Milestones are to be achieved and for Substantial Completion and readiness for final payment are identified in the Construction Service Contract (or incorporated therein by

reference to the specific language of the Bid). **Substantial Completion is desired on or before December 7, 2018 and Project Final Completion is desired on or before June 1, 2019. Substantial Completion will require all items of work to be complete and the road open to traffic with the exception of final restoration and final punch list items.**

SECTION 00 41 00 - BID FORM

4. Delete the BID FORM section in its entirety and replace with the revised BID FORM included in this addendum (Pages 4A). The replacement bid form includes revised formatting and the total pages now match that of the table of contents. **There is no change to the total quantities or units.**

- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has obtained and carefully studied (or accepts the consequences for not doing so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by Bidder, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.
- E. Bidder does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- F. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.

- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
- J. Bidder will submit written evidence of its authority to do business in the state where the Project is located not later than the date of its execution of the Agreement.

4.01 Bidder further represents that:

- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over Owner.
