

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

### COPPER HARBOR WWTP LAGOON #2 MODIFICATIONS Grant Township Copper Harbor, Michigan

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Copper Harbor WWTP Lagoon #2 Modifications will be received by Grant Township, at the Grant Township Clerk's Office, 232 Gratiot Street, Copper Harbor, Michigan until 4:00 p.m. local time on Wednesday, May 23, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project consists of constructing temporary modifications to the secondary lagoon (#2) to provide additional aeration capacity and effluent decanting to lagoon #2 in order to provide secondary treatment to meet NPDES permit limits.

The project will potentially be financed through the MDEQ Surface Water Quality Initiatives Grant Program and requirements for State Prevailing Wage Rates and Buy American Iron and Steel (AIS) will apply.

Bidding Documents may be obtained after May 9, 2018 at 12:00 p.m. at the office of the Engineer upon payment of Forty dollars (\$40.00) non-refundable deposit. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. Bidders should direct correspondence to the Engineer.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond or certified check for a sum no less than 5% of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes plainly marked with the project name and the name of the bidder.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the Bids. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the Owner and any Bidder or Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to accept any or all Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the Owner, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the Owner.

A voluntary pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 a.m. local time on Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at Copper Harbor WWTP.
