

DOCUMENT 00 11 13 - ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1.1 PROJECT INFORMATION

- A. Notice to Bidders: Qualified bidders may submit bids for project as described in this Document. Submit bids according to the Instructions to Bidders.
- B. Project Identification: Menominee Public Schools Ceiling Replacement.
 - 1. Project Location: Menominee High School, 2101 18th Street, Menominee, Michigan 49858.
- C. Owner: Menominee Area Public Schools.

- E. Project Description: Installation of new classroom and corridor lighting, and SAP ceiling. Installation of new data cable, jacks and fiber.
- F. Project construction will follow the asbestos abatement and fireproofing work under another contract. See phasing plan on drawings for schedule details.
- G. Project is anticipated to be substantially complete by **Tuesday, August 30, 2016**.

1.2 BID SUBMITTAL AND OPENING

- A. Owner will receive sealed lump sum bids until the bid time and date at the location given below. **Owner will not consider or accept a bid received after the date and time specified for bid submission.** Owner will consider bids prepared in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders issued by Owner, and delivered as follows:

 - 2. **Bid Time: 10:00 a.m. (Central Time)**
 - 3. **Location: 1230 13th Street, Menominee, MI 49858**
- B. Bids will be thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

1.3 REQUIRED AFFIDAVITS

- A. Affidavit of Bidder – Familial Relationship Disclosure
 - 1. Each bid shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Menominee Area Public Schools Board of Education or the

Superintendent of Menominee Area Public Schools. **The Owner will not accept a bid that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.**

2. Complete and submit the "Affidavit of Bidder – Familial Relationship Disclosure" form included with Procurement and Contracting Requirements.

B. Affidavit of Compliance – Iran Economic Sanctions Act

1. Each bid shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement that the bidder is not an "Iran linked business" within the meaning of the Iran Economic Sanctions Act, Michigan Public Act No. 517 of 2012. **The Owner will not accept a bid that does not include this sworn and notarized statement.**
2. Complete and submit the "Affidavit of Compliance – Iran Economic Sanctions Act" form included with Procurement and Contracting Requirements.

1.4 BID SECURITY

- A. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check made payable to Menominee Public Schools or a satisfactory bid bond for 5 percent of the base bid.
- B. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of **90 days** after opening of bids. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities.

1.5 PREBID MEETING

- A. Prebid Meeting: A **mandatory** prebid meeting for all prime bidders will be held at the Project Site on **Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.**, local time.
