BRIDGE ROAD PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS ELECTRICAL MODIFICATIONS AND PLC UPGRADES Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority Ypsilanti, Michigan

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Bridge Road Electrical Modifications and PLC Upgrades will be received by Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority, in the Engineering Department of the Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority at 2777 State Road, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48198-9112 until 2:00 p.m. local time on Friday, May 11, 2018, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project consists of the addition of a variable frequency drive to existing 300 hp (water) centrifugal pump and upgrading the existing PLC cabinet.

Bidding Documents may be obtained after Tuesday, April 17, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. at the office of the ENGINEER upon payment of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) non-refundable deposit. An additional, non-refundable charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be required for mailing Bidding Documents. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. Bidders should direct correspondence to the ENGINEER.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond for a sum no less than 5% of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes plainly marked with the project name and the name of the bidder.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the Bids. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the Owner and any Bidder or Bidders. The OWNER reserves the right to accept any or all Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the OWNER, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the OWNER.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 9:00 a.m. local time on Tuesday, April 24, 2018 at the Bridge Road Pump Station. Bidders that fail to attend will be unable to bid on the project.
