The City of Farmington, the OWNER, will receive sealed Bids for the Twin Valley Pump Station Improvements project at the office of the City Clerk located at 23600 Liberty Street, Farmington, MI 48335 until October 28, 2015 at 1:00 PM local time. No Bids will be received after that time. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time and place.

This project consists of the construction of a sanitary sewer pump station with backup power, 175 ft of 6-in force main, and 55 ft of 12-in gravity sewer.

Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the actual date of opening thereof. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the Owner and any Bidder or Bidders.

The OWNER reserves the right to accept any or all Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the OWNER, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the OWNER.
