The Ypsilanti Community Utilities Authority, the OWNER, will receive sealed Bids for the North Golfside Pump Station Retaining Wall project in the Engineering Department at the Eldon P. Ahles Administration Building, located at 2777 State Road, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48198 until February 10, 2016 at 2:00 PM local time. No Bids will be received after that time. Immediately thereafter, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Board Room.

The Project consists of construction of a retaining wall structure and adjusting sanitary structures.

Bidding Documents may be obtained after January 27, 2016 at 1:00pm at the office of the ENGINEER upon payment of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) non-refundable deposit. An additional, non-refundable charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) will be required for mailing Bidding Documents. Neither Owner nor ENGINEER will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. Bidders should direct correspondence to the ENGINEER.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond for a sum no less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes plainly marked with the project name and the name of the bidder.

YCUA reserves and has the right, in YCUA's sole discretion: to reject or accept bid/proposal, including without limitation, a non-conforming, non-responsive, unbalanced, incomplete or conditional bid/proposal; to waive any failure to comply with or fully satisfy the requirements of bid specifications or the specifications of a request for proposal; to extend the time for filing a bid or proposal; to reject the bid/proposal of any bidder/proposer if YCUA believes it would not be in the best interest of the project or YCUA to make an award to that bidder/proposer; to reject the bid or proposal of any bidder/proposer whom YCUA finds, after reasonable inquiry, to be nonresponsible; to waive all informalities not including price, time or changes in the work; or, to negotiate contract terms with the apparent successful bidder/proposer.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the proposal.

There will be no Pre-bid meeting for this project. All questions regarding the plans and contract book must be submitted in writing no later than three (3) days prior to bid opening.
