Bidding Documents may be obtained after Wednesday, October 5, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the office of the Engineer upon payment of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00) non-refundable deposit. An additional, non-refundable charge of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) will be required for mailing Bidding Documents. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. Bidders should direct correspondence to the Engineer.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond for a sum no less than 5% of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Bids shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes plainly marked with the project name and the name of the bidder.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the Bids. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the Owner and any Bidder or Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to accept any or all Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the Owner, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the Owner.

The Five Mile Road Booster Station will be open to interested parties on Monday, October 17, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. until Noon.
