FERRIC CHLORIDE TANK REPLACEMENT

The City of Dexter, the OWNER, will receive sealed Bids for the FERRIC CHLORIDE TANK REPLACEMENT project at the City, Attn: Courtney Nicholls, 8123 Main Street, Dexter, MI 48130, until Wednesday, July 6, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. local time. No Bids will be received after that time. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time and place.

This project consists of removing an existing 6,000 gallon FRP tank previously used to for ferric chloride storage and replacing it with a new double-wall FRP tank in the same location. The Work also includes:

- Constructing a concrete support slab for the new tank
- Piping, valves and fittings to connect the new tank to the existing buried chemical feed pipe
- Heat tracing and insulation of exposed piping
