FERRIC CHLORIDE TANK REPLACEMENT

CITY OF DEXTER, MICHIGAN

The City of Dexter, the OWNER, will receive sealed Bids for the FERRIC CHLORIDE TANK REPLACEMENT project at the City, Attn: Courtney Nicholls, 8123 Main Street, Dexter, MI 48130, until March 18, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. local time. No Bids will be received after that time. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time and place.

This project consists of removing an existing 6,000 gallon FRP tank previously used to for ferric chloride storage and replacing it with a new FRP tank in the same location. The new ferric chloride tank will be placed in an existing FRP spill containment tank that is set with about two-thirds of its height into the ground. The work will include excavating to the bottom of the spill containment tank and cutting and patching the spill containment tank to accommodate the pipe connections to the new ferric chloride tank. Minor piping work is involved to connect the new ferric chloride tank to the existing chemical feed pipe. The work also includes constructing a wood framed shelter top over the ferric chloride tank.

Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the actual date of opening thereof. This time period may be extended by mutual agreement of the OWNER and any Bidder or Bidders.

The City reserves the right to accept any or all alternative Bids and award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, to waive any irregularities or informalities or both; to reject any or all Bids; and in general to make the award of the Contract in any manner deemed by the City, in its sole discretion, to be in the best interest of the City of Dexter.
